Meotosugi

A famous, large, dimorphic cedar tree, believed to be around 500-600 years old.

A testament to the worship of Mt. Oyama in Edo period, this 3 m 68 cm marker was first erected in 1716, and was carried up from the base of the mountain by guides of the time.



Minoge

Minoge was once the site of an oshi priest settlement. When the weather is clear, the town offers a great view of Sagami Harbor and Izu Oshima Island.

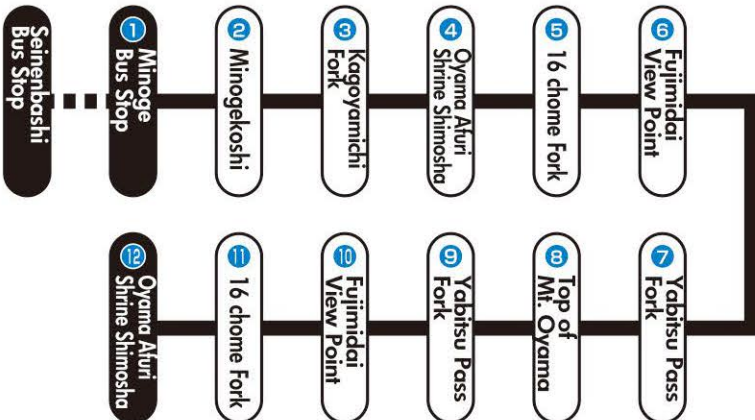

Minoge Trail was once the main route up the mountain. This time-worn trail can be followed all the way up to Minogekoshi.



Tohaimon

Currently one side of the gate is left open year round, but in former times the gate was kept shut except for during the great summer festival period, with entry strictly prohibited.
